Proposed sale of Huish Park to SSDC

- Roger, brought up the suggested costs of purchasing and running the club if the Glovers Trust were to activate the ACV.
- John suggested we need to arrange a meeting with Scott Priestnall as soon as possible (preferably before Christmas) so that the fans can get the answers they require.
- It was discussed that there's no reason for Scott to sell to the Glovers Trust regardless of whatever bid was made.
- Still plenty of question regarding the deal so urgent meeting to be requested.
- Propose a date of Tuesday 22nd December to meet with Scott Priestnall and publicise our request.
- Suggest polling amongst fans on social media groups with heavy Glovers Trust branding.

Members Poll

- 78 replies to board election issued the below results regarding the sale of Huish Park to SSDC
 - 2.5% strongly support
 - 15.4% felt positive
 - 30.8% needed more information
 - 37.2% had concerns
 - 14.1% strongly opposed



Members Vote

- It was suggested that members should rely on the board to make the decision after gaining member feedback. The general feeling was that it was important not to devalue our membership and use the opportunity to increase membership by letting fans know their voices will be heard and that they count.

Short Term Membership Drive

- Renewals are from 1st of July but have adjusted to 12-month period since joining.
- Price of membership will remain at £10 for 12-month period.
- Mark and Adam to work together to generate ideas.

Questions posed to Scott Priestnall on 10.12.2020

- Questions sent privately to Scott Priestnall were not yet answered and more will be put together by board ahead of potential meeting on Tuesday 22nd December.

- Advertise for Secretary – Brendon to find job description and ask unelected members who applied for board to take up the role.
- Thanks to Leslie for her assistance as the previous Secretary of the Trust.
- Artist who created the Martin Baker Glovers Trust stand has offered to create a ham stone fan memorial for the memorial garden on Tony Lock Avenue at Huish Park.
- Ian to re-work on the website in the New Year to bring it up-to-date.
- Adam wants to schedule monthly meetings through the year.
- Mark would like some long-term membership ideas to be shared so we can work on a plan.
- Terri praised Scott for many of the positive initiatives he's managed to get through in his time running the club.
